Build an Instrument

Follow these instructions and learn how to build your own Trumpet and String Instrument out of house hold items!







What you'll need:

- Paper Towel Tube
- Tape (painters or masking tape works best)
- Plastic Bottle
- Scissors
- Paper

Step 1: Carefully, (and with adult help) cut out the top off of the plastic bottle (make sure it is a little bit bigger than the paper towel tube)

> Optional: Decorate your paper towel tube

Step 2: Tape the top of the bottle to one end of the paper towel tube








Step 3: Cut your paper into a square

Step 4: Create a funnel out of the construction paper square and secure with tape


Step 5: Tape the construction paper funnel to the end of the paper towel tube







Practice your **buzzing** and enjoy your new trumpet!



How to buzz: keep your lips together and push air through (similar to a raspberry)



String Instrument:



What you'll need:

- Small Cardboard Box
- Paper Towel Roll
- Tape or Glue
- 4-5 Rubber Bands
- Scissors
- 2 Pens or Pencils

String Instrument:

Step 1: Carefully, (and with adult help) cut out a circle in the second half of the box



Optional: Decorate your box!



Step 2: Make 4-5 small cuts in ones end of the paper towel roll and attach with tape or glue to the top of the box



String Instrument:

Step 3: Carefully pull rubber bands over the box, resting over the hole



Step 4: Bring the two pens under the rubber bands at the top and bottom of the box

Tip: Angle the pencil on the top of the box so the 'strings' are different lengths
